



## **Community Engagement**

### GENERAL OVERVIEW:

- I. More than 36,000 Southern Nevadans including families with children, couples, and individuals of all ages will be homeless at some point this year.
- II. This is devastating for those families and individuals, and significantly impacts all taxpayers as local government budgets pay for the medical care, police and social services that serve the homeless
- III. Government entities, nonprofit organizations, faith-based groups and corporate partners work together to provide homeless prevention and assistance programs that have helped reduce the number of homeless in Southern Nevada. But we still have a long way to go.
