Unaccompanied youth make up **31%** of the total homeless population on any given night.

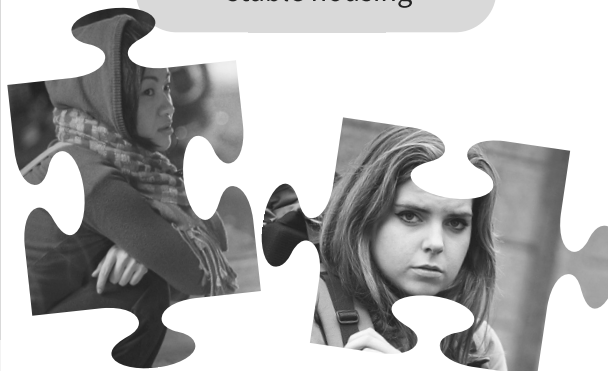
Sexual Victimization

According to national estimates it costs **\$53,665** to maintain a youth in the criminal justice system for one year, but only **\$5,887** to permanently move a homeless youth off the streets and into housing and services.



39% of foster youth in Clark County who were in foster care 3+ years exited without stable housing



One out of every three teens on the streets will be sexually victimized within 48 hours of leaving home. Over 33 percent of homeless youth report exchanging sex for food or shelter.
