YOUTH HOMELESSNESS

Unaccompanied youth make up 21% of the total homeless population on any given night.



NV is #3 in the nation in total number of inaccompanied youth experiencing homelessness.




By region, Las Vegas has the 2nd highest rate of unsheltered unaccompanied youth in the nation.

92% In Fact


9 out of 10 or 92% homeless youth are unsheltered in Clark County on any given night.




In Southern Nevada, 214 of homeless youth on any given night are children under 18.



1,081 of homeless youth are between 18 and 24.



Over 1,295 unaccompanied youth are homeless in Southern Nevada.



15,000 children and youth are in households that are unstably housed, such as multiple families sharing a single family residence, or families staying in weekly hotels.
