Serving homeless vets in LV since 2001, over 300 beds for veterans

Main Site: Located at 525 East Bonanza Road, est. 9/8/2001

The Radcliff: 2566 Sherwood Street, est. 7/1/2011



- ▣ 118 Veterans In Progress (VIP) transitional beds; residential back-to-work program
- ▣ 9 Permanent Housing units for vets with disabilities
- ▣ 10 Housing units for Chronically Homeless vets (CHAMPS 1)
- ▣ 14 beds for Chronically Homeless vets (CHAMPS2) at “The Radcliff”
- ▣ 11 Long-Term Supportive Housing beds – The Radcliff, operated by U.S.VETS
- ▣ 25 Transitional to Permanent Housing units for single veterans; scattered site (TIP)
- ▣ In start-up now: 25 Permanent Housing units for vets with disabilities, to include families; scattered site (PH2)
- ▣ Support to 95 beds in Cloudbreak Communities, co-located at the main site

U.S.VETS also operates the Supportive Services for Veteran Families Program and Incarcerated Veteran Transition Program.

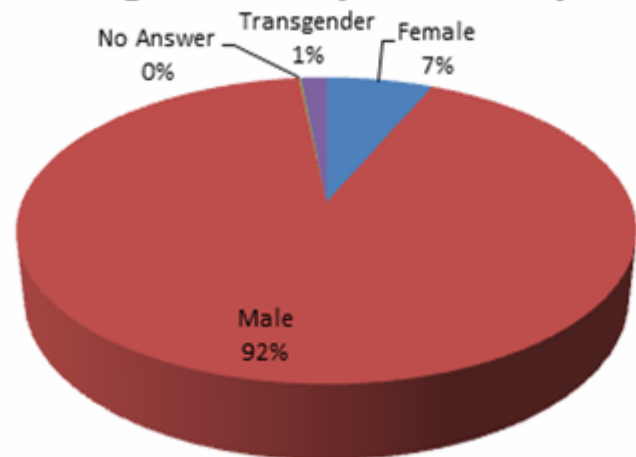

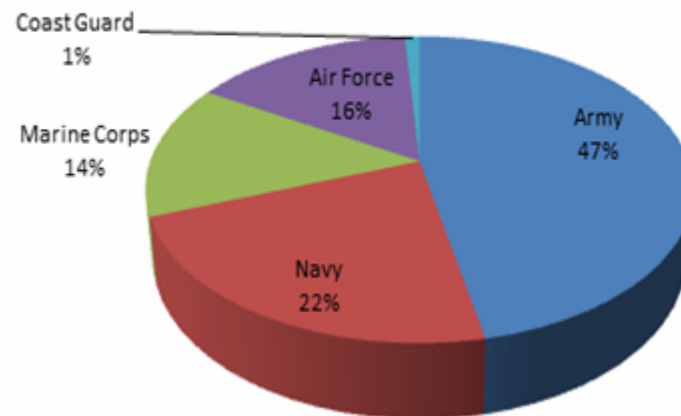


VETERAN DEMOGRAPHICS 2013

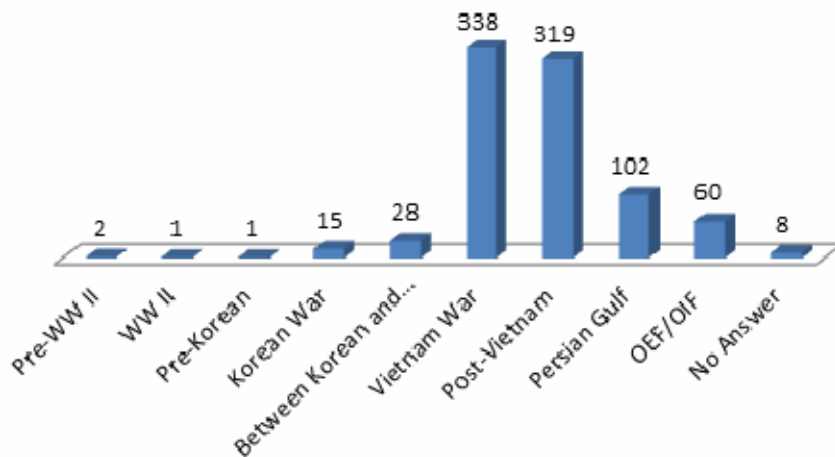
What gender do you identify as?
