Outcomes

- **Goodwill of Southern Nevada met with 70 clients regarding job readiness and resources**
- **City of Las Vegas met with 21 families for Housing and Foreclosure Assistance**
- **Over 25 families learned about free life insurance programs through Mass Mutual LifeBridge Program**
- **5 Clients were seen by Nevada Council on Problem Gambling for treatment and referral**
- **CCSD provided Title One HOPE information to 44 families**



Outcomes, continued

- **Women's Development Center connected with 48 clients regarding housing programs**
- **Nevada HAND connected with 34 families regarding family housing**
- **DA Family Support provided information and assistance to 25 families**
- **HELP of Southern Nevada made 11 follow-up appts for housing and services**
- **63 Clients received information on Nevada 211**



Outcomes, continued

- **Multiple Behavioral and Mental Health Agencies provided information on PSR/BST and Day Treatment, adult outpatient, child outpatient, clinical, and therapy**
- **United Way of Southern Nevada provided 46 clients with information on preschool and childcare assistance**
- **3 higher education firms provided information to over 69 families for continuing ed and scholarships**
- **7 families were issued benefits through WIC**
- **Medical/Dental/Vision service information given out by 3 medical providers**



Outcomes, continued

- **32 clients connected with summer programming for their children through Boys and Girls Clubs**
- **Over 47 clients connected with Parenting Resources through DFS and University of Nevada Cooperative Extension**
- **13 clients were provided with Alcoholics Anonymous meeting schedules**
- **DWSS saw 47 unduplicated clients and provided information and applications for Medicaid/TANF and SNAP, and case inquiries**
