What does this provide?

- Transitional Renewal Projects
 - 59 units for families
 - 365 units for individuals
 - 203 units for veterans
 - 42 units mentally ill
 - 120 other individuals
 - 44 units for homeless children and youth



What does this provide?

- SHP Permanent Housing Renewal Projects
 - 12 units for Families
 - 30 units for individuals
 - 20 chronically homeless
 - 10 disabled veterans

What does this provide?

- Special Projects
 - Safe Haven—25 units for severe mentally ill individuals
 - SAFAH Link—move-in assistance for 21 units or 79 individuals

What does this provide?

- Shelter Plus Care (S+C) Permanent Supportive Housing
 - 241 units for Mentally Ill
 - 20 families w/ children
 - 139 individuals
 - 82 chronically homeless

What does this provide?

- New Projects
 - 92 permanent supportive housing units for families
 - 48 veterans (25 units) includes families
 - 38 individuals with Co-occurring illness (Substance abuse + mental illness)
 - 6 pregnant/parenting youth/young adults with their babies
 - HMIS Dedicated Enhancement Project

Summary

- 2011 HUD CoC Consolidated application request was \$6,695,644
- We received \$6,630,235
- SNAMHS received \$65,508 less due to FMR reductions
- Southern Nevada Children First received \$1.00 less than requested
