Who we are

Project 150 is a 501(c)3 non-profit charitable organization that was organized in December, 2011 when the founders heard about 150 homeless high school students at Rancho High School in Las Vegas that were in need of support over the Christmas Break. The effort has expanded to helping over 1,100 in 34 area high schools when it was understood that the problems these students faced were prevalent across the valley.

There are over 6,300 homeless students in the Las Vegas valley. *High School is Tough Enough* without having to worry about where you are going to sleep at night. Project 150 was created out of our communities desire to help these kids. Our mission is to offer support and services to these homeless high school students so they have what they need to continue school and be successful in life.

The most needed **school supplies** are pens, pencils, highlighters, paper, spiral notebooks, notebook dividers, and calculators - simplistic to scientific calculators, glue sticks, index cards, protractor & compass sets, USB flash drives, combination locks for lockers, and backpacks. **Food items** needed include juices, crackers, instant soup, instant oatmeal, Jell-O, pudding, Hershey's chocolate, protein bars, pop-tarts, granola bars, chips – non-perishable items that can be carried. Gently used or new teen appropriate **clothing** and **NEW** small fleece throws, briefs, under shirts, white socks, dress socks, bras, panties, and tank tops. Personal hygiene essentials are crucial.

Project 150 is a non-profit charitable organization founded in December 2011 by two Nevada Natives who heard of 150 homeless students at Rancho High School. Since then, Project 150 provides food, clothing, school supplies, sports equipment, shoes, and other special requests to over 1,100 homeless, displaced, and disadvantaged high school students. We are currently serving 34 high schools and will add additional schools as schools allocate resource rooms. Project 150's goal is to collaborate with schools and community organizations to maximize resources and allow students to focus in achieving graduation. Eventually, we wish to add a mentoring program with a pay-it-forward component to promote sustainable college and career readiness.
