CoC Program

- HEARTH Act combines all previous projects into one “CoC Program”
 - Supportive Housing Program (SHP)
 - Shelter Plus Care (S+C)
- Standardizes the match requirements
- Standardizes services

 - 5 New Project Applications
- Presentations scheduled for August 20 & 21, 2012
- Requested follow up information from project applicants
 - Due August 31st

- Re-opened the CoC Local application process for rapid rehousing projects only
- Applications due to September 12, 2012
- Rapid Rehousing presentations scheduled for September 25, 2012
- HUD CoC Registration is open and is due October 1, 2012
