



# Youth at Risk of Homelessness Planning Project (YARH)

■ Purpose of funding is to build ***intervention strategies*** for youth and young people who are most likely of experiencing challenges in transition to adulthood, to include homelessness and unstable housing experiences. (2 yr grant)

■ Target Populations:

- Youth entering foster care between the ages of 14-17
- Youth aging out of foster care
- Young adults (under 21) accessing homeless support services with former child welfare history.
- Youth in multiple systems (Juvenile Justice), victims of human trafficking, etc.

■ Core activities developed during Phase 1 are expected to produce positive outcomes to include :

- Stable Housing
- Permanent connections
- Education/employment
- Enhanced well-being

■ Planning Framework:

- Leadership Steering
- Subcommittees– focus on Data Strategy, Capacity, Stable Housing, Education/employment, Well-Being



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
