Coordinated Intake

- Coordinated Intake is a single access point or process for people to receive prevention, housing and /or other related services
- Key step in assessing and prioritizing the needs of the homeless requesting assistance
- Matching the needs of those households to the most appropriate housing and service options
- Required by HUD as designated by the HEARTH Act

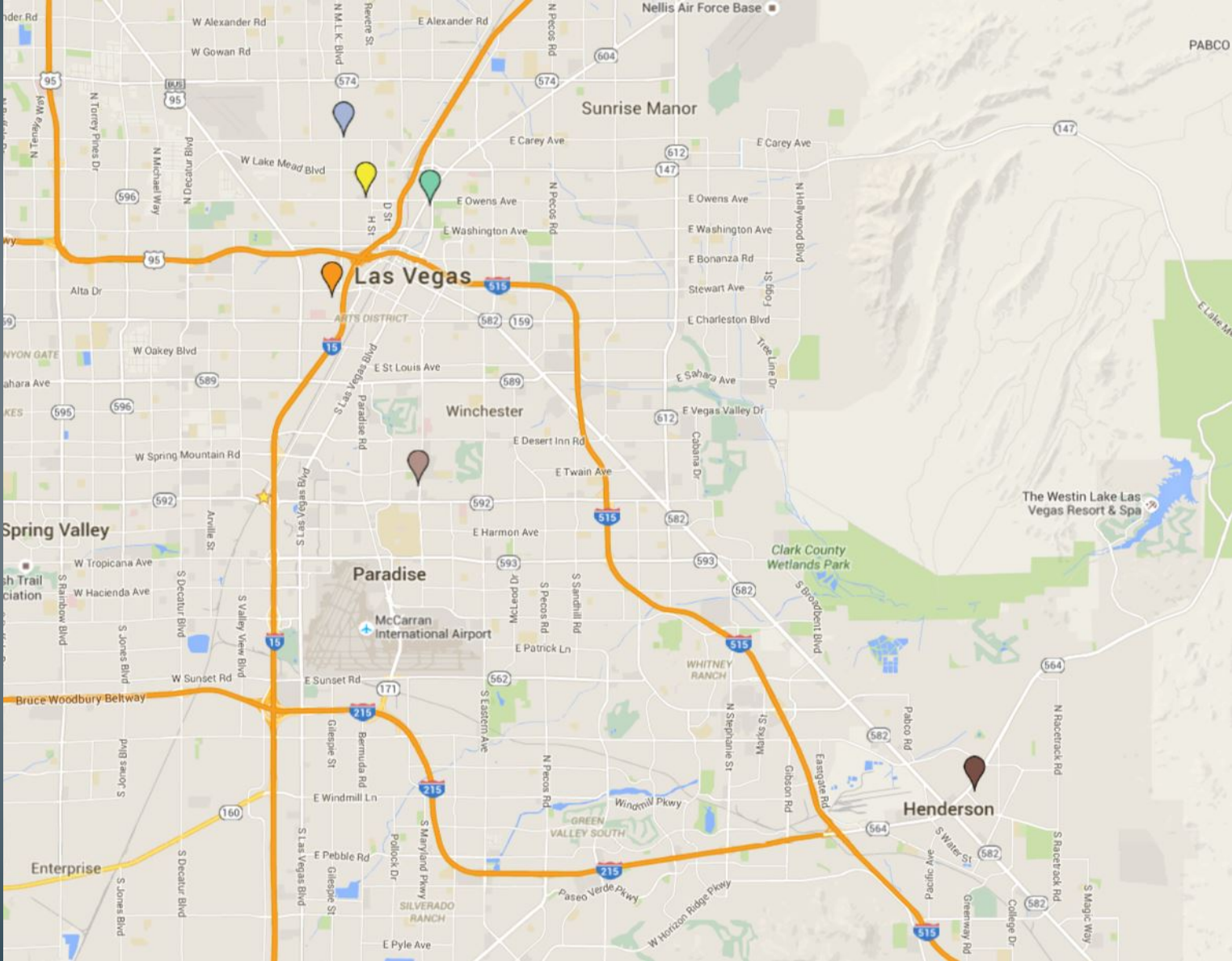


Components of Coordinated Intake

- Standardized Access –Centralized entry point for families and individuals facing a housing crisis.
- Standardized Assessment - All sites use the same assessment and targeting tools; all make referrals using the same criteria and have access to the same set of resources.
- Coordinated Referral - A coordinated referral process for all clients.

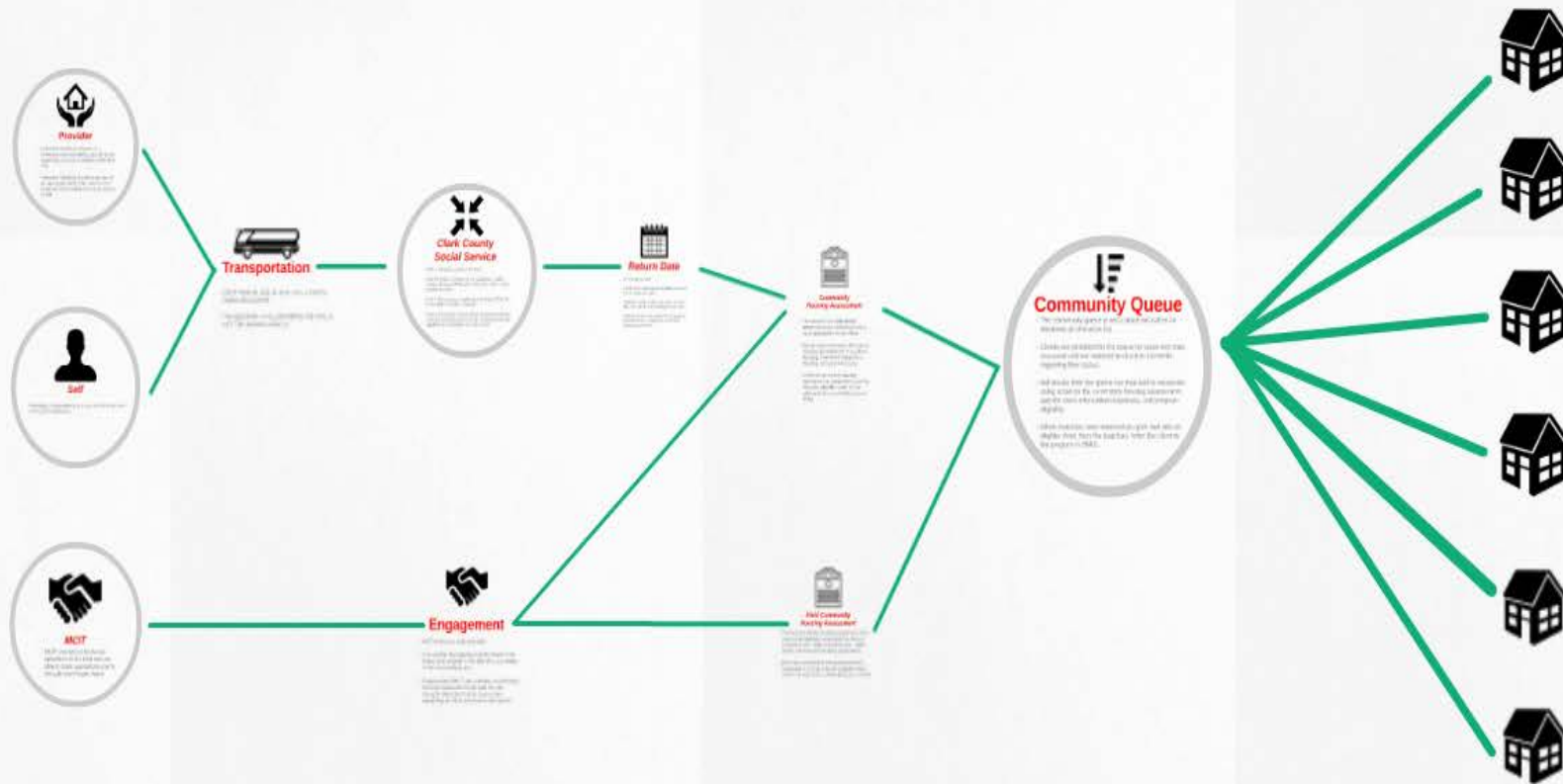


Coordinated Intake Sites

Point of Entry

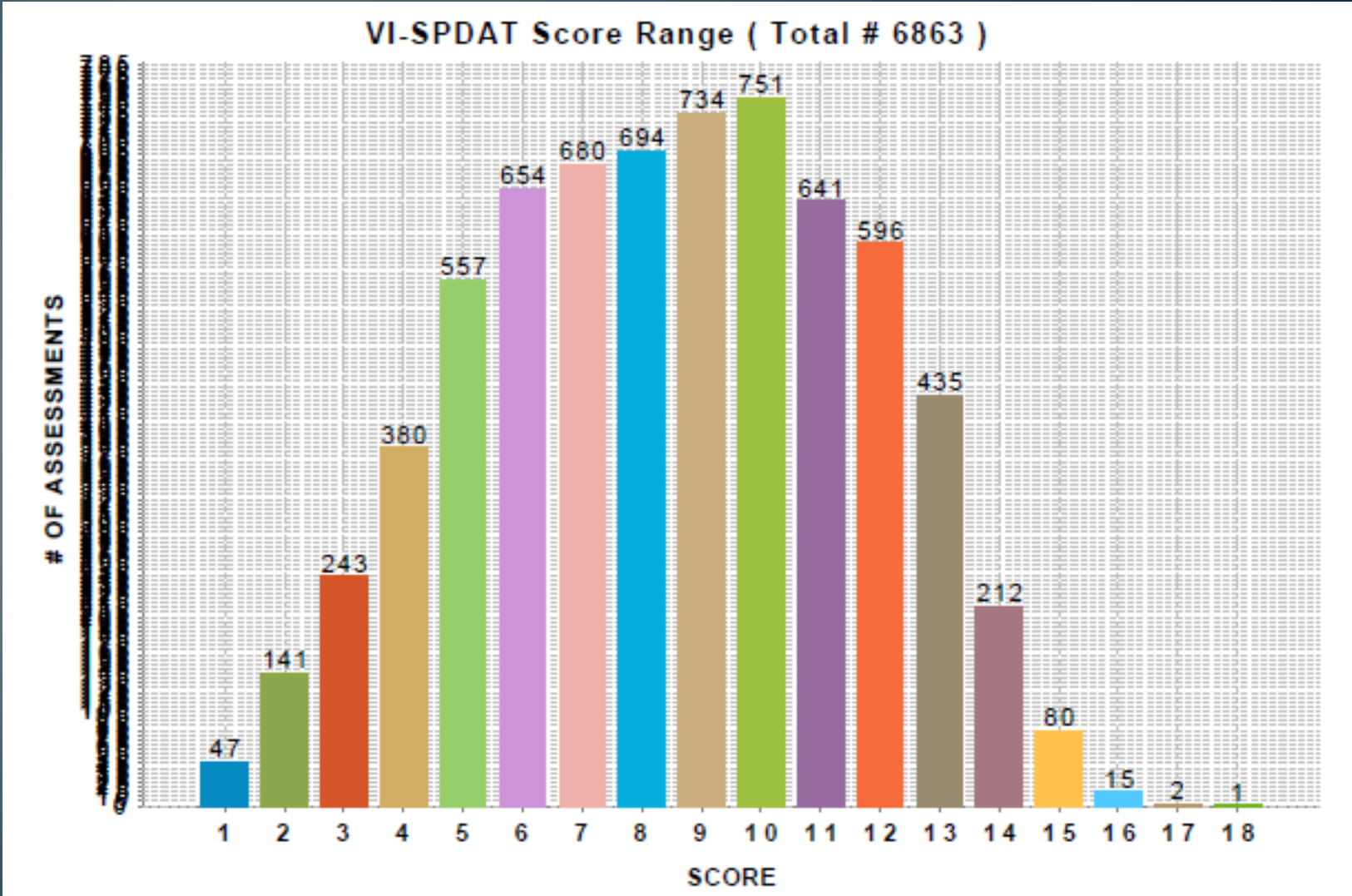

- Standardized assessment tool
- Coordinated Intake Evaluation Recommendation:
 - Create supplemental tool to VI-SPDAT or create a new tool
- Southern Nevada Community Housing Assessment Tool created by Coordinated Intake Change Advisory Team
- Will assess not only broad range of issues, but will also assess the extent of the issues
- Companion tools are currently being developed
- Will start implementation this Fall.

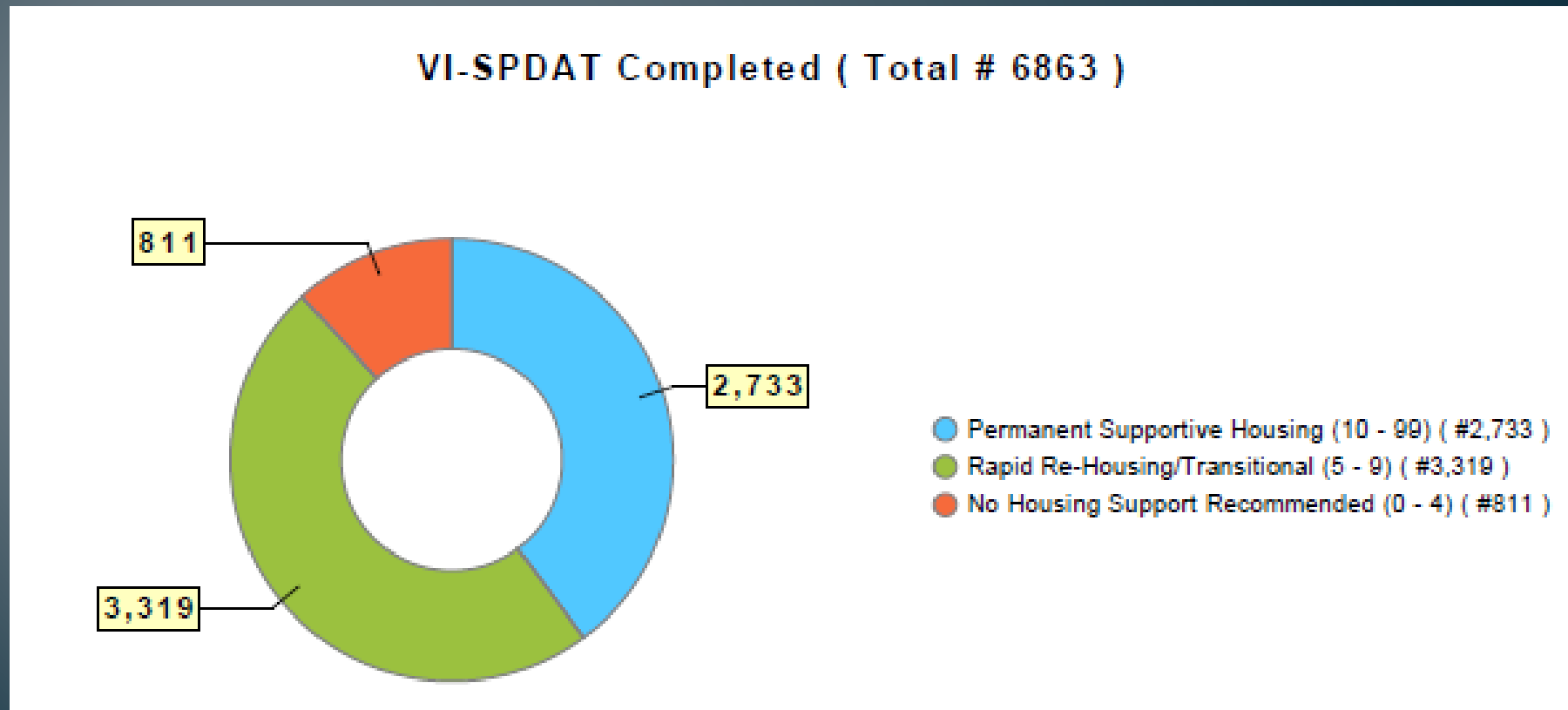
Score Range (7/1/2014 - 8/16/2016)

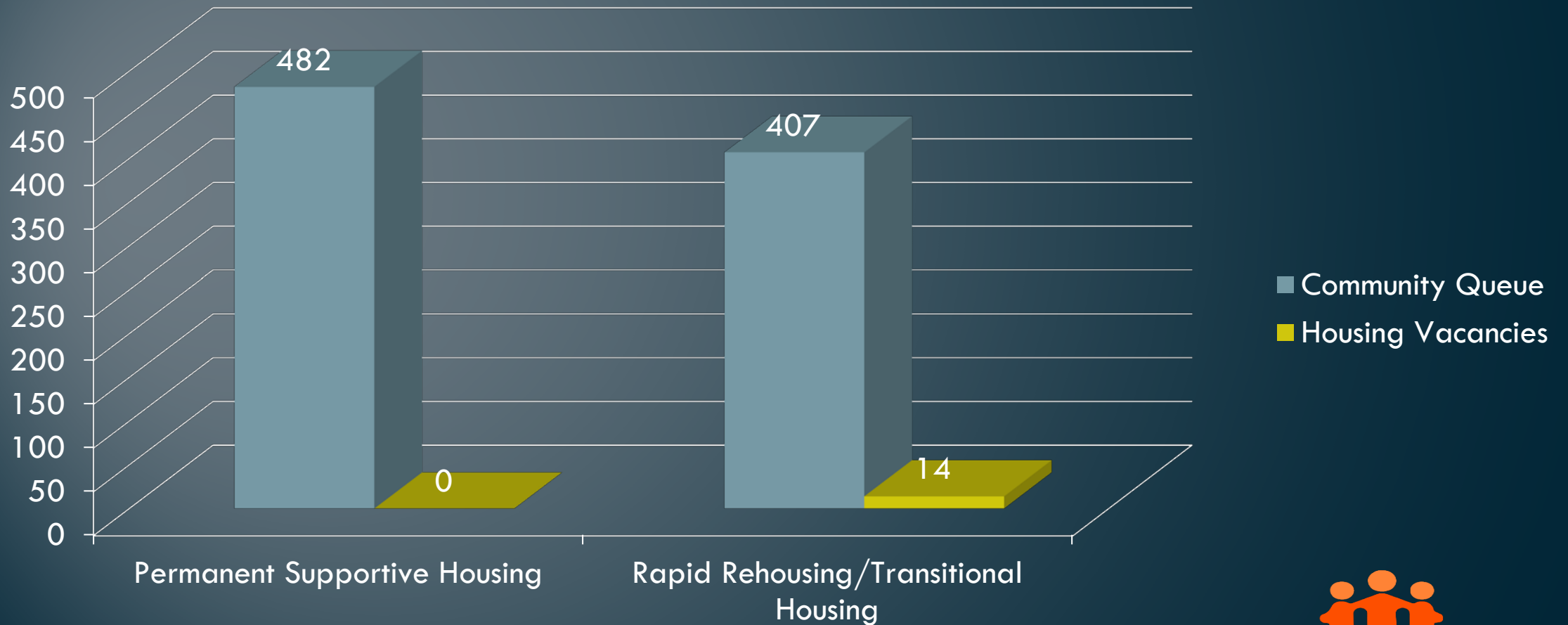
