<b>Main Goal Purpose of RFP</b>	The purpose of the YHDP is to learn how communities can successfully approach the goal of preventing and ending youth homelessness by building comprehensive systems of care for young people rather than implementing individual or unconnected projects that serve this population.  CoCs must understand subgroups: -Pregnant and parenting -LGBTQ -Minor Age Youth  CoCs must collaborate with traditional and non-traditional youth homelessness stakeholders to provide resources, services, advocacy and policy making. CoCs must also engage a youth advisory board that includes homeless or formerly homeless unaccompanied youth.

<b># and Amount of Funds Available</b>	~CoC may apply for a minimum of \$1 million per budget period for a minimum of \$2 million throughout the total funding period (48 months) ~CoC may apply for up to \$15 million  <i>Additional notes:</i> ~up to 10 CoCs will be awarded \$1 million plus a percentage of \$23 million distributed based on population size and poverty rates of the awarded CoCs ~up to 4 of the awarded CoCs will be rural areas ~CoC may apply for 1 grant of \$1M or multiple smaller grants that equal a total of \$1M
<b>Funding Period</b>	48 months    2 year grant term eligible for renewal
<b>Matching OR Cost Sharing</b>	The recipient must match all grant funds, except for leasing funds, with no less than 25% of funds or in-kind from other sources
<b>Impact to ARD</b>	If awarded, the grant amount gets rolled into the CoC's Annual Renewal Demand amount; YHDP grants may be eligible for 1 year renewal terms after the initial grant term expires, beginning with the next CoC program competition.
