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## New Crossings ( St. Jude's) – RRH - TAY

- 19 units/32 bed
  - 13 households with one adult and one child
  - 6 adult households without children
- Homeless Coordinated Care Project (HCCP – West Care) – PSH
    - 24 units/24 beds/24 CH dedicated beds
    - Serving 48 Households without children

**Projects Not Funded**



- Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) Projects
  - 928 Bed/ 696 units
    - 1253 CH Beds
    - 7 Youth

Provide?**



- **Rapid Rehousing Renewals**
  - 291 Beds / 126 Units
  - 8 Youth Beds
- **Transitional Housing**
  - 187 Beds/69 Units
  - 64 Youth Beds

**Housing the Homeless ( *Salvation Army*) – (\$269,754)  
– RRH**

- 26 units/26 beds
  - 26 households without children

**Welcome H.O.M.E. ( *Lutheran Social Services*) – (  
\$285,988) – RRH**

- 21 units / 64 beds
  - 15 households with 1 adult and 1 child
  - 6 households without children

**Homelink ( *HopeLink*) – ( \$362,446) – RRH**

- 17 units ( adults with at least 1 child) /77 beds
  - 17 households with 1 adult and 1 child
