Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

1. Update on Jurisdictional ESG Funding and Projects

- Clark County reported that Clark County's Community Development Advisory Committee (CDAC) made recommendations for FY18-19 and there were 12 projects recommended for funding with 8 rapid rehousing projects and 4 emergency shelter projects. Focus areas were emergency shelters and rapid re-housing programs serving youth, victims of domestic violence, and intact families
- City of North Las Vegas's Citizen's Advisory Council (CAC) made recommendations for FY18-19 to fund 3 agencies. Emergency shelter and rapid rehousing projects were also the focus for the City of North Las Vegas.

2. 2018 Youth Homeless Demonstration Project

- NOFA for the 2018 Youth Homeless Demonstration Project (YHDP) was released by HUD on January 17 and the application is due April 17. More community input is needed. Forms are available if anyone would like to participate as a stakeholder, current resource capacity, or on the YHDP Team if award is received. Submit interest forms by Thursday, March 15 and commitment letters are due by Thursday, March 22. Final application is due on April 17.

3. 2018 Continuum of Care NOFA

- Monitoring Working Group (MWG) was in attendance and will start desk monitoring in March into April. Anticipate the consultant coming onboard to start on-site monitoring soon. The MWG have made a recommendation on a selected consultant.
- The EWG and MWG reviewed each question and section in the local application and made comments/revisions for consistency with the 2017 eSNAPS application were sent to ZoomGrants and they created a new application specific to SNV CoC
 - The new application discusses program requirements and provider requirements to apply, as well as certificate language around Fair Housing and Equal Opportunity (FHEO) requirements
 - It was suggested to add links to HUD website instead of spelling it out
 - The Library section can include additional documents that would otherwise be posted on the HelpHopeHome website
 - Branching questions will be added later by ZoomGrants because they are hard to re-order later
 - Population types need to match HUD definitions
 - The section regarding participation in regional events needs more consideration
 - Depth of participation – the groups need to decide how to score and monitor this
 - Stopped at question 47 and will resume edits at the next joint meeting on March 14
