# What investment was made?

- Application:
  - Over 200 hours of staffing from CCSS
  - Over 200 hours of staffing from community partners
- When Awarded:
  - Over 3,000 hours committed to serving as the YHDP Lead – valued at over \$160,000
  - Over 3,500 hours committed to working on the community plan when awarded – valued at over \$145,000



# YHDP Application Strengths



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- CCSS serving as the Lead
  - Michele Fuller-Hallauer supported by the equivalent of 1.5 full time employees from the CCSS Resource & Development Team
- Community Infrastructure
  - Youth Action Board
  - Coordinated Entry for Youth
  - Point-in-Time Youth Count and Survey
  - Community-wide Needs Assessment completed at The Summit
  - Community Stakeholders committed to developing a coordinated strategy to prevent and end youth homelessness to be debuted at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Summit in November 2018

    - Functional Zero for Veterans, Coordinated Entry for all Subpopulations
