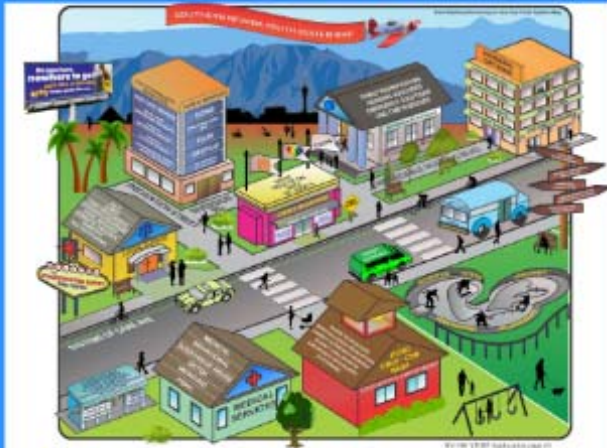

Funding Formula

HUD will begin with 16 communities, half of which will be rural and will apply a formula based on the number of youth (age 12 to 24) in poverty in the each community multiplied by the 2-bedroom FMR for the geographic area. This "formula factor" will be used to create a community ratio which will be used to determine award amounts for each community. All communities will also receive an initial amount of \$1 million.

Projects

Projects will be for an initial 2 year grant term.

Planning Projects will be for 1 year terms and are non-renewable.
