- August 21st – The Salvation Army – 189 served
- September 18th – Lutheran Social Services of Nevada – 217 served
- October 16th – The Center – 72 served

2018 Outcomes

Housing

- 42 housing assessments
- 40 check-ins
- 8 matched to housing

Hygiene

- 201 showers
- 1040 received clothing
- 169 haircuts
- 974 hygiene kits

2018 Outcomes

Health Care (Medical, Dental, Vision, Mental/Behavioral)

- 121 received same day basic medical care
- 166 vaccinations
- 219 HIV tests
- 68 clean syringe kits
- 17 overdose reversal drug
- 197 vision screenings, 42 eyeglasses or frames
- 35 mental/behavioral health program enrollments and/or intakes
- 244 received recovery support
- 163 appointments for follow-up care

2018 Outcomes

Benefits & Care Support

- 217 received Medicaid, Medicare, SNAP, and/or Social Security assistance
- 5 same day EBT cards
- 65 pets assisted (supplies, food, vaccinations, medication, grooming)
- 57 assisted with birth certificate recovery
- 23 assisted with Nevada ID recovery
- 32 veterans assisted with VA benefits claims
- 1062 bus passes
- 31 federal phones

- 102 received employment support
