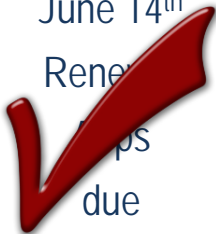

What are we eligible to apply for?

Tier 1 (Estimated ARD at 94%)	\$13,059,461
Tier 2 (ARD minus Tier 1)	\$1,472,543
Permanent Housing Bonus	\$692,000
DV Bonus	\$1,129,323
CoC Planning (not ranked)	\$415,200
Total Possible to Apply For	\$16,768,527

- Flexibility in Housing First
- Evidenced Based Approach
 - Cost Effectiveness a must



What's Needed?

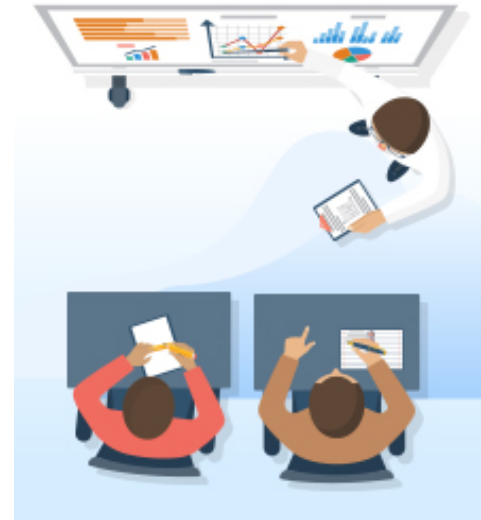


- ***MOU with Workforce***

DV Bonus Update

- May submit multiple project types with the exclusion of SS0-CE.
 - Rapid Rehousing (RRH)
 - Joint Transitional Housing- Rapid Rehousing (Joint TH-RRH)
 - Conversations with DV Providers began back in April
 - VSPs that were in attendance were encouraged

- Joint TH-RRH project
