Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- The system modeling work group has continued to work on system modeling and populating new modeling tools.
- Susan Starrett and team presented the new system modeling tools to the CoC board.
- The team is preparing to present the new system modeling tools to the AB73 work group.
- The real time system modeling will be for year 1 with the broader system modeling being years 2 through 5.
- System modeling is important and impactful to our community and has aided in the development of the RSF4 Housing surge.
- Catherine presented the draft one-sheeter to the group and reviewed the data.
- There were concerns that shelter beds are under-utilized, and suggested breaking down utilization rate by program to better demonstrate overall utilization of available beds.
- Group decided to hold off on releasing one-pager until confident with data, with the goal of releasing the data to the SNHCoC Board on August 13th.
- 100-week challenge to house 3500 people by June 30, 2022.
- To accomplish this challenge three teams will need to be established: the leadership team, communications team, landlord engagement team, and the performance and data management team.
- The Data and Systems Improvement Working Group will take on the function of the performance and data management team by looking at the data surrounding the housing surge.

- Group discussed the new Pandemic Prioritization Exception (PPE).
- Going forward group will work to determine parameters upon which to measure provider usage of HMIS.
