### Working Group: Joint Housing Working Group, a subgroup of the Planning Working Group

Jurisdictional updates were provided at the start of the meeting on response to COVID-19 and CARES Act Funding. Michele Fuller-Hallauer and Kristin Cooper with Clark County Social Service provided a report out on work being done in RSF-4 through the County MACC/EOC to stand up housing to assist the community with transitioning from the Emergency Support Function in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Michele and Kristin have charged this group with assisting in increasing housing stock and inventory in our community as part of the Landlord Engagement and Unit Acquisition Team as a component of the work being done in RSF-4. This group has already identified that as a goal, so it seemed like a logical fit for that work to sit with this working group. Rick will run point on this for now and will garner interest from the group on who would be interested and willing to participate in this work as part of that group and will get back to Michele and Kristin.

Development: No updates

Private Engagement: Landlord Lunch and Learns will now need to be figured out how they can be done virtually but will be starting up shortly to ensure that we keep a connection with our landlords. It was suggested that landlords that have applied to receive funds from Clark County through CRF funds be approached about dedicating units to the SNH CoC. CCSS will soon be launching a Landlord Mitigation pool/fund to assist landlords in paying for client damages to units. Tenancy Training will all be up and running soon but may look very different under concerns of COVID.

Systemic Level Engagement: SNRHA has not been present at the table but Rick has agreed to reach out to his connections to see if they are willing to have a representative join the group.
