Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- Group discussed the COVID-19 and the importance of being transparent and collecting information from clients in an effort to stop the spread of COVID-19.
- Group discussed possible new training team CE Assessors training. Training will be recorded and available to view online.
- Group discussed the User Policy for HMIS. Users of HMIS should review the User Policy.
 - Failure to adhere to the rules of the User Policy could result in a permanent ban from the HMIS system.
- Group discussed the Updated Data Standards that go live date is October 1st.
 - New CE APR will be submitted by October 1, 2021.
- Bitfocus will be conducting a compliance review for the new APR and the Emergency Queue.
- Emergency Shelter Queue process is specifically for people who need emergency shelter.
 - Client can be referred through an Assessor or through the shelter queue.
 - Emergency Shelter Queue went live on September 1st, and currently 30 clients on the Queue.
- 480 people on the housing queue identify as high risk for COVID-19.

- Currently there are 1506 clients on the Queue, 581 chronically homeless, 115 families, 90 youth, not chronic with income is 357 and 38 veterans.
- Group discussed the Housing Surge Coordination, which is still awaiting approval from County Management.
- Currently 1537 Clients on the queue, 630 chronically homeless; 119 families & 74 youth.
