# Mission Statement

The Title I Homeless Outreach Program for Education of the Clark County School District works to remove barriers for homeless students to enroll in school and educate school personnel, parents and unaccompanied youth of the educational options under McKinney-Vento federal law.



# McKinney-Vento Federal Requirements

- ❑ Eligibility
- ❑ Immediate enrollment
- ❑ School of origin
- ❑ Transportation
- ❑ Remove barriers
- ❑ Provide services
- ❑ Professional Development/Training



# McKinney-Vento Definition of Homelessness

Children and youth who lack a *fixed, regular, and adequate* nighttime residence

- Unsheltered
- Residing in a shelter or Transitional Housing Program
- Doubled up
- Hotel/Motel



# Identifying Students

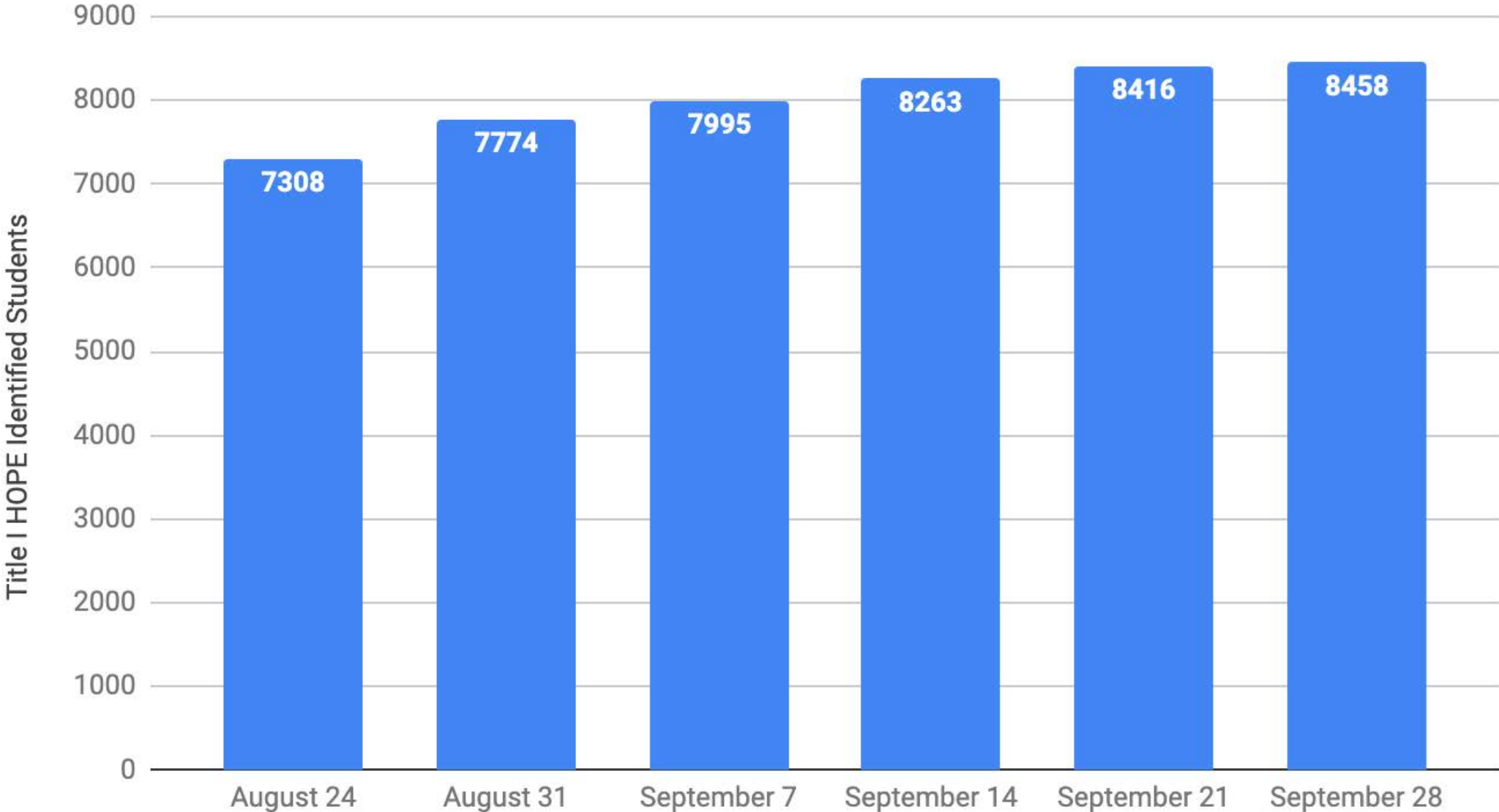
- ❑ Families/students self identify during online registration
- ❑ Community agency/school staff can assist in identifying students
- ❑ Procedures in place to identify students during the school year
  - ❑ Train CCSD/Community staff
  - ❑ Ensure information is posted where parents/students see it
  - ❑ Continuously determining eligibility (new and current students)

# 2020-2021 Enrollment

- Online Registration
  - Through online portal
  - Call School
  - Make appointment at school for assistance
- Eligibility after enrollment
  - Complete Title I HOPE Student Housing Questionnaire
    - Clerks/Registrars
    - CIT Advocates
    - Title I HOPE Staff

# 2020-2021 School of Origin

The **school** that a child or youth attended when permanently housed or the **school** in which the child or youth was last enrolled, including a preschool.

- ❑ Normally, students re-qualify for SoO
- ❑ Title I HOPE School of Origin Rollover
  - ❑ Students that are eligible under McKinney-Vento for 20-21 were automatically approved to attend their school of origin
  - ❑ Letters sent to parents/students/schools prior to the start of school





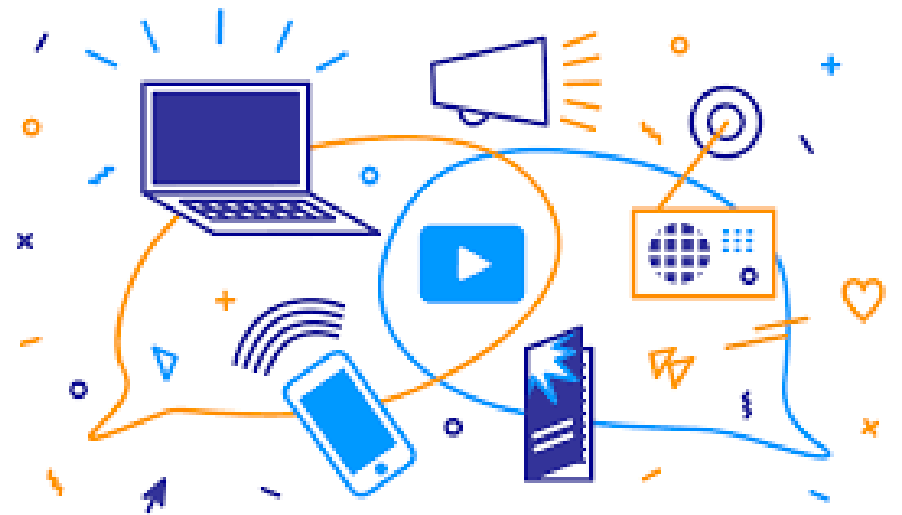
# School of Origin & Transportation

- ❑ Transportation is issued for students on school of origin in alignment with CCSD transportation regulations.
- ❑ This includes CCSD busses and RTC passes.
- ❑ All transportation is on hold during distance learning

# Family Support Center

- ❑ Family Support Center Mission
- ❑ Documentation of connectivity/device needs for distance learning
  - ❑ Cox Internet Setup
  - ❑ Hotspots
  - ❑ Devices
- ❑ Parents/Students pick up devices/hotspots at their designated schools
  - ❑ Cox router sent directly to customer

# HOPE/Family Support Center Collaboration

- ❑ Began Thursday, September 3rd w/high schools
  - ❑ HOPE provides reports by school
  - ❑ Who is coded, who has/needs devices/internet
- ❑ Support Center calls every household on the list
  - ❑ Address all students in a household
  - ❑ Transportation for pick up @ schools
- ❑ Spreadsheet is sent to CIT Advocate at each school for follow up
- ❑ HOPE provides a daily brief for CCSD Board (M-F)

# Family Support Center Data as of Friday, October 2, 2020

- ❑ Total Title I HOPE students: 8,497
- ❑ Total # of students contacted: 5,268
- ❑ Total # of high schools completed: 51 (including alternative and special schools)
- ❑ Total # of middle schools completed: 54
- ❑ Total # of elementary schools completed: 110
