Overview

- 29 bed facility located on the main campus of the Southern Nevada Health District at 280 S. Decatur Blvd.
- Facility for COVID-19-positive clients who need a safe place to isolate but don't require hospitalization:
 - Clients experiencing homelessness
 - Clients who live in crowded households
 - Clients who live in households with a high-risk individual
 - Clients who live or stay in congregate shelters
 - Visitors
- Part of an overall response plan to help reduce the demand on hospitals and to prevent the spread of COVID-19 within the community

Eligibility Criteria

- Clients must:
 - Be 18 years of age or older
 - Have a positive COVID-19 test and are still within their infectious period
 - Be able to perform their own activities of daily living (ADL's)

Those Not Eligible for Admission

- Children
- Those needing a place to quarantine
- Those awaiting results of a COVID-19 test
- Those requiring the level of care normally provided at a hospital or a skilled nursing facility
- Those requiring assistance with their own ADL's
- Those requiring oxygen therapy
- Those requiring nebulizer treatment
- Those under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs or who are dependent on alcohol or illicit drugs
- Those with behavioral or psychiatric issues that may pose a risk to themselves, other clients, or staff
- Those unwilling or unable to remain at the facility through the duration of their isolation period

Provisions

- 24/7 nursing care
- Case managers
- Private space with a bed and linens
- Bathrooms and showers (with towels and soap/shampoo)
- Three meals a day, plus snacks and water
- A shared area to relax and watch TB
- Designated times to be escorted outside to smoke
- Secure storage area for belongings

Making a Referral

- New clients are accepted daily from 10am – 8pm
- Call 702 759-1840 to discuss the referral process
- Facility's Medical Director will determine client's eligibility
- If accepted, either the client or the facility referring client will need to arrange for transportation
