Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- Michele Fuller-Hallauer and the City of Las Vegas gave a presentation to the staff at Sunrise Hospital on discharge procedures for individuals that have been hospitalized due to COVID-19.
- Team will meet with other hospitals around the valley to ensure consistency within the discharging process.
- Ashley Barker Tolman, HUD TA from Cloudburst, is working with the Southern Nevada Health District to provide more testing availability.
- The group continued the discussion on the Housing Surge.
- The RFP for the Housing Surge has been advertised.
- The Housing Surge RFP will provide grant dollars to form a centralized agency to provide rent dollars for Rapid Rehousing, Case Management team and support services.
- An Assessment and Matching team still needs to be formed to establish the process for getting people placed in housing and coordinating with the Coordinated Entry System.
- Case Management Services will be light touch at first but will increase as client needs.
- Currently 1975 people on the community queue.
- 400 people were added to the queue between October 1st and November 1st.
- 57 million dollars total needed.
- 37 million in funding available.
- Group discussed the Emergency Shelter Queue process.
- Bitfocus will continue to work with providers on the Emergency Shelter Queue process to ensure accuracy.
- Group will continue to discuss the Southern Nevada Housing Surge and HMIS data within the Coordinated Entry System.
