

City of Las Vegas - Recuperative Care Center

What is the Recuperative Care Center (RCC)?

RCC is a medical respite program that maintains 40-beds, provides medical care 24/7, safe shelter, meals/snacks, case management and other stabilization services to individuals experiencing homelessness who are too ill/frail for the streets but are not ill/frail enough to remain in hospital (to include pre/post-surgical procedures).

This is short-term care for non-chronic medical conditions that would be exacerbated by living on the street, in shelters or places not meant for human habitation.

Referrals

Who can make referrals?

RCC currently accepts referrals from the following:

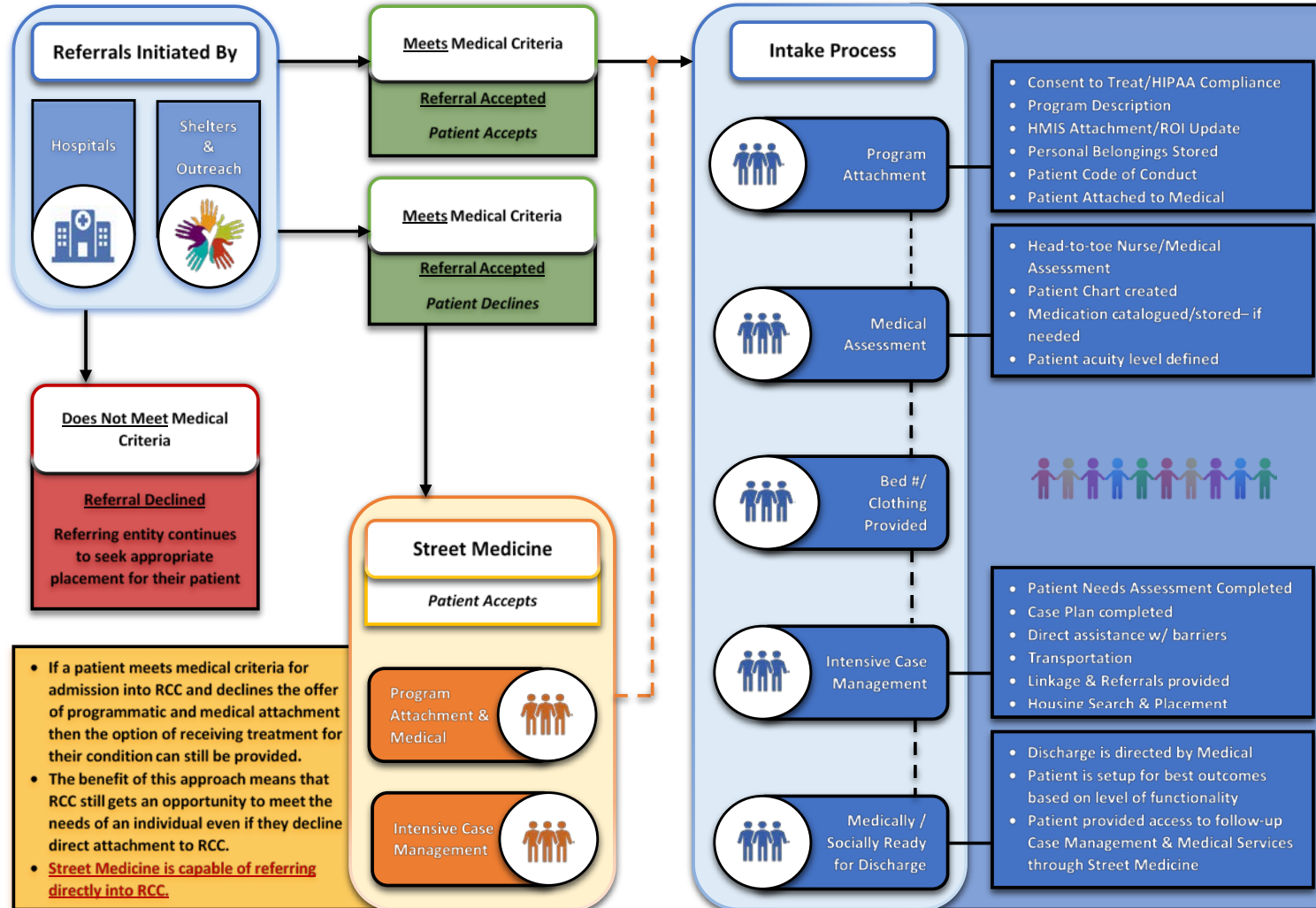
- ▶ Hospitals/Clinics: Monday - Friday, 8:00AM - 10:00PM
- ▶ Shelters
- ▶ Outreach Teams

The first step in making a referral is to call the RCC at (702) 229-5160 to check on bed availability. Staff will explain the next steps in the process for referrals, if we have bed availability.
