Accomplishments - Action Items Completed

- The Longitudinal System Analysis (LSA) report was completed on January 15th and the final submission is complete.
- Point-In-Time (PIT) count will take place the night of January 27th and continue through January 28th.
 - Sheltered data will come from HMIS.
 - Outreach groups will cover the unsheltered count.
 - Census team will collect data from VA'S HOMES database.
- There were 345 public alerts from October 1st through December 31st, 35 BOLO alerts, 275 alerts for transportation, 4 alerts from Southern Nevada Health District.
- There are currently 900 people on the Emergency Shelter queue.
- Bitfocus is currently working on a coordinated Entry compliance review.
- Group discussed new monitoring tool for compliance.
- The group reviewed the HMIS application from Chicanos Por la Causa.
