Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- **2021 PIT Count update**
 - Matt Manlangit shared the final census numbers with the group.
 - The team will present the data at the CoC board meeting.
 - The team is gearing up to send data to HUD.
- **Priorities for local applications**
 - The group discussed local priorities for the 2021 local application.
 - Coordinated Entry will prioritize rapid rehousing and continue build upon the efforts of Operation home.
 - Recommended local priorities for 2021 will include.
 - Maintain funding for high performing programs.
 - Maintain funding for system level needs-HMIS and Coordinated Entry.
 - Prioritize RRH, especially for single adults, and continue to build upon the efforts of Operation home.
 - Prioritize any bonus project.
 - The recommended list of local priorities will be forwarded to the Evaluation Working Group.
- **Emergency Housing Vouchers**
 - Michele Fuller-Hallauer shared an overview on Emergency Housing vouchers.
 - The Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority is eligible to receive 586 emergency housing vouchers.
 - These vouchers are targeted for the homeless population.
 - SNRHA must receive referrals through the Coordinated Entry System
- **Operation HOME data dashboard update**
 - Group discussed the System Modeling Report.
 - Dashboard Data go live date is June 8th
- **Next steps**
 - The group will continue discussion regarding PIT Count data.
