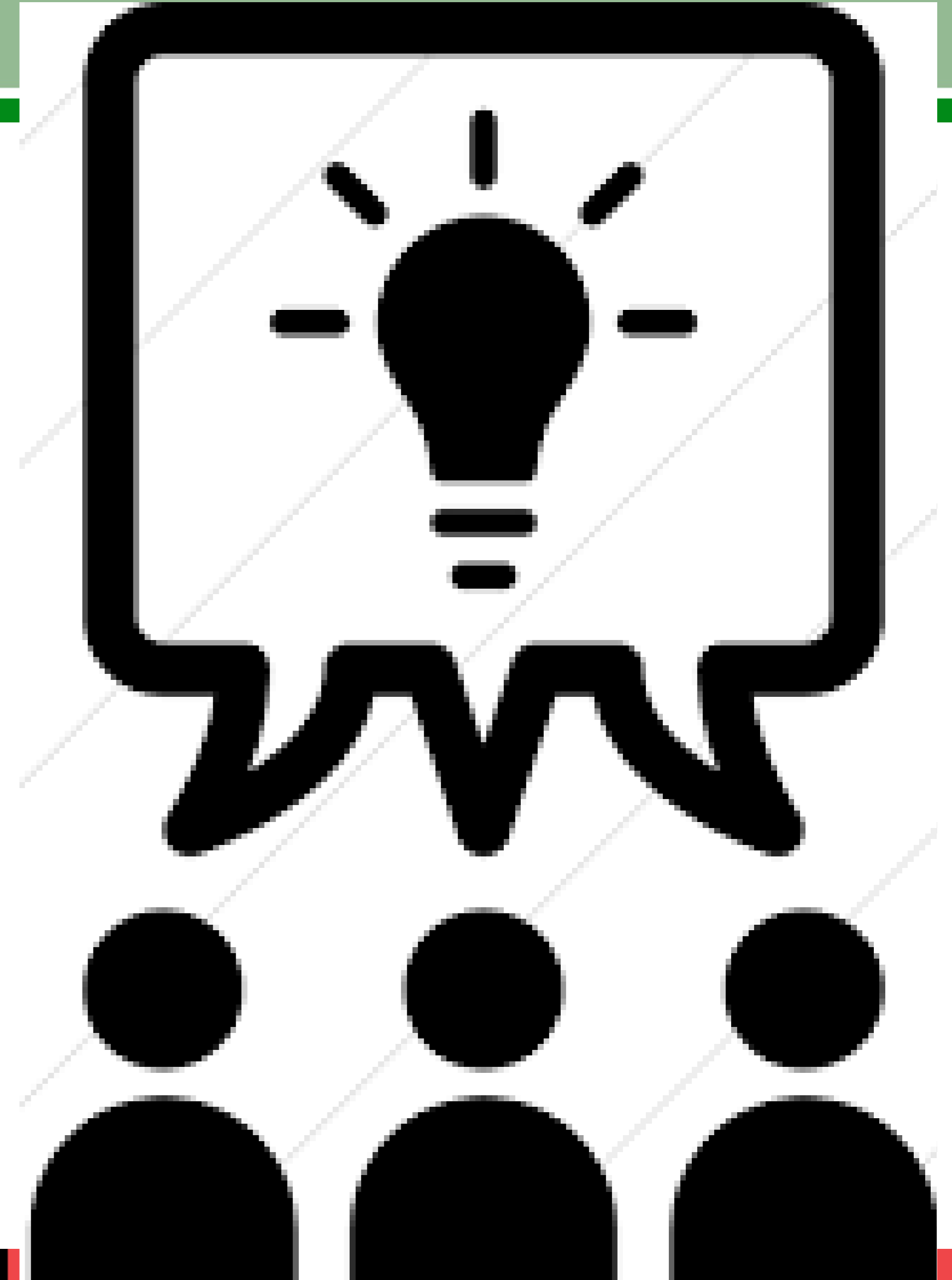

ABOUT OUR

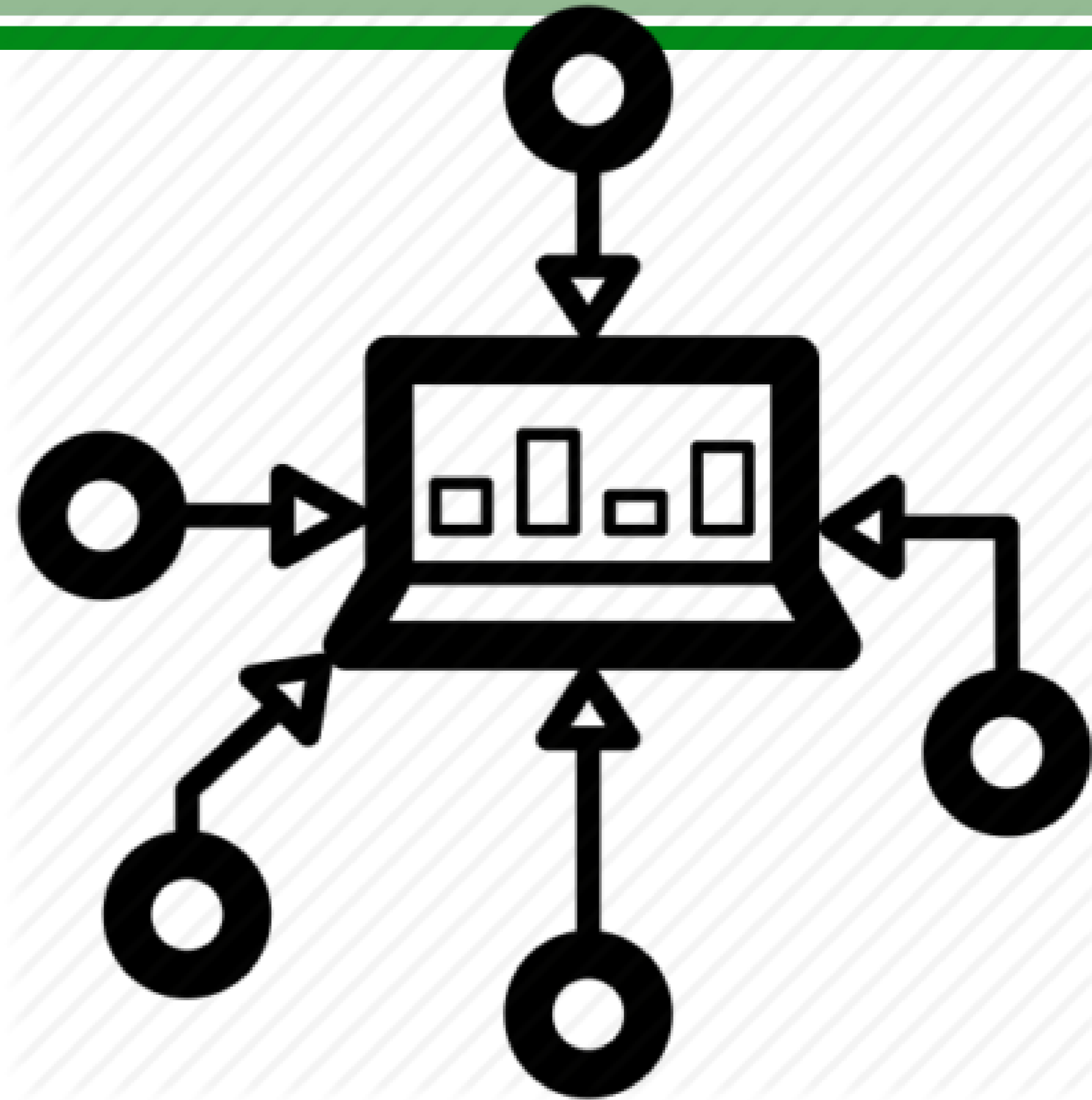
COLLABORATIVE PROJECT

- Three-year partnership between the UNLV Schools of Public Policy and Leadership and Social Work working together with community partners
- Community Partners include:
 - Clark County Social Service
 - Nevada Homeless Alliance
 - CCSD Title I Hope Program
 - Nevada Partnership for Homeless Youth
- Goal: Prioritize research projects that will impact homelessness in the state



MAPPING DATA SYSTEMS

- A common goal of all partners is to have improved integration of data systems from systems that impact clients
- An early question that has emerged: Can we map the unique and common features of data systems that work with vulnerable populations in Nevada?

Connect with key stakeholders in across service delivery systems to identify:

- Types of data collected
- Populations
- Use of data
- Integration with other systems
 - Common data elements
 - Types of sharing and integration
 - Integration limitations

Create data system mapping that can be used for data integration planning

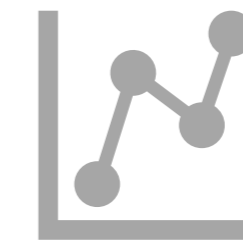
METHODOLOGY
