Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- **Equity Analysis**
 - The system modeling process begins by looking at population and performance data to understand the needs of households experiencing homelessness.
 - Then communities use that knowledge to envision a system that could respond fully to all households experiencing homelessness.
 - Data will look at what makes some subgroups perform better relative to the universal goal and what makes some subgroups perform worse.
 - Data will look at the length of time some subgroups experience homelessness.
- **Emergency Housing Vouchers**
 - The Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority is eligible to receive 586 emergency housing vouchers.
 - These vouchers are targeted for the homeless population.
 - SNRHA must receive referrals through the Coordinated Entry System
 - Team will present information regarding EHV at the CoC Board meeting.
- **Operation HOME data dashboard update**
 - Group discussed the Performance Scorecard.
 - CSH has been working with different working groups to discuss program housing types.
 - The groups have been working to develop a minimum standard and community goal for most of the quality elements already determined based on the data quality plan.
 - The groups have determined specific key performance measures for each program type.
- **Next steps**
 - The group will continue discussion regarding PIT Count data.
 - The Group will continue to discussion regarding Emergency Housing Vouchers.
