Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- **Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) discussion**
 - HUD has allocated 70,000 EHV to public housing agencies from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
 - The Southern Nevada Regional Housing Authority (SNRHA) received 586 EHV's on July 1st, 2021.
 - The EHV's are valid through September 30, 2030 and may be reissued through September 30, 2023
 - To qualify for the Emergency Housing Voucher Program, a client must be homeless or at risk of becoming homeless, fleeing, or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking, and recently homeless.
 - Referrals must come through the Coordinated Entry process.
 - The group discussed prioritization for EHV.
 - Clients who have manufactured drugs or have been convicted of a violent crime will not be eligible to receive EHV.
 - 34 referrals have been processed.
- **Operation HOME update**
 - The contracts for 13 agencies have been completed.
 - 42 referrals have been made to OH! Case managers.
- **Equity Analysis**
 - The team is in the process of requesting domestic violence data.
 - The team is working on a draft survey to send out to assessors app.
 - The group will continue discussion at the next CESWG meeting
- **Next Steps**
 - Group will discuss Emergency Housing Vouchers at next meeting.
 - Group will continue discussion on Equity Analysis.
