Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

- **Update on Jurisdictional CDBG & ESG Funding, projects, and CARES Act planning**
 - ESG and CDBG -CV dollars are being used to find 13 agencies to hire about 40 case managers.
 - The Landlord Engagement Team and Property Services Team is still looking for available units.
 - Individuals that are considered high-risk for negative impacts of COVID-19 are being prioritized to move from non-congregate shelter into available rapid-rehousing units.
 - City of North Las Vegas is waiting for fiscal agreements to be sign.
 - Clark County is currently waiting to receive award letters from HUD.
 - The City of Henderson is waiting on funding and developing a plan for ARPA funding
- **2021 CoC Competition updates**
 - New applications opened on September 7th and are due by October 4th.
 - Scoring and Ranking Team reviews will be held on October 5th through the 14th.
 - Deliberations begin on October 18th and appeals are due by October 22nd.
 - Consolidated application is due to HUD by November 16th.
 - All component s of the local application will be posted to www.helphopehome.org.
- **Monitoring Work Group**
 - The team just completed the ESG monitoring.
 - Final letters and the initial survey have been sent out from Strategic Progress.
- **Data and Systems Improvement Working Group**
 - The group discussed Equity Analysis and the Data Dashboard.
 - Equity Analysis analyzes data to determine the demographics of who is being housed, referred, and denied.
 - The group has been discussing Emergency Housing Vouchers.
 - 574 clients have been referred for Vouchers.
 - 251 clients have already attended a briefing session.
 - 12 clients have been withdrawn for not showing up for the criminal history checks or for being non-compliant with the program.
 - 87 clients are scheduled to receive their vouchers this week.
- **Youth Working Group**
 - YHDP was not awarded from this year's competition.
 - Group is still meeting on the 4th Tuesdays of the month from 9am to 11am
- **Quarterly Joint Meeting with Monitoring, Evaluation, and Data and Systems Improvement Working Groups**
