- **RRH to PSH**
 - The group discussed transitioning clients from Rapid rehousing to Permanent Supportive Housing.
 - The RRH to PSH group is still working on a draft of the policy and procedures.
 - Group discussed implementation of policy within the Coordinated Entry System.
 - The Coordinated Entry Task Force will discuss client transition from RRH to PSH.
- **Equity Analysis**
 - The group discussed the creating a small group to analyze the Equity Analysis Data.
 - The group will be responsible for making recommendations and developing next steps.
 - The group will present the data to the Steering Committee and then the CoC Board meeting.
- **Emergency Housing Voucher (EHV) update**
 - Landlords will receive \$500 incentive pay for leasing up.
 - There are a total of 1157 referrals.
 - 213 of those referrals are currently looking for housing.
 - 109 clients have leased up.
- **Operation HOME! update**
 - There are currently 486 referrals for Operation HOME.
 - The Landlord Engagement team is still in need of Landlords.
 - Landlords now have a portal on the HHH website where they can engage with the leaps team.
