**Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:**

- **Jurisdictional update**
  - Operation HOME! 384 households have been housed.
  - Group is working on a call to action for local landlords.
  - CLV is Wrapping up ESG contracts for outreach for the 2022 fiscal year.
  - CLV is in the process of drafting CDBG contracts with agencies for 2023
  - City of Henderson is working on an ESG-CV grant with the state.
  - Gearing up for the 2022-2023 fiscal year.
- **Youth Homeless Demonstration Program**
  - The team discussed the Youth Needs Assessment.
  - The team is working with Tact as a third-party facilitator to do a Youth Needs Assessment in the community around youth homelessness.
  - The team will continue to review data to measure equity within the system.
- **2022 CoC Competition updates**
  - The group has created an interest form for those interested in becoming a member of the scoring and ranking team.
  - 10 applications have been received so far.
  - Alternate list of SRT members will be created.
  - Homebase will facilitate a CoC 101 training for SRT members on July 21<sup>st</sup>.
  - Training will be virtual.
  - Homebase and CCSS have been working on a threshold checklist.
  - New application instructions mirror the previous application instructions.
  - The group discussed options for a new 3<sup>rd</sup> party facilitator to assist with the CoC competition.
- **Monitoring Work Group update**
  - The scores have gone out to the applicants regarding the last monitoring session
  - This year's monitoring scores have decreased due to COVID affecting the programs spend down rates
  - Monitoring session is currently in the appeals process.
  - Initial numbers have been given to Homebase.
- **Data and Systems Improvement Work Group update**
  - Team is working on finalizing Homeless Census data to present to the Board.
  - The group is in the planning phases for the 2023 Homeless Census.
  - The Homeless Census Work Group will meet on the third Monday of the month beginning on July 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am.
- **Youth Working Group**
  - Team is working on YHDP and Youth Needs Assessment.
