**Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:**

- **Jurisdictional update**
  - Operation HOME! 420 households have been housed.
  - Group is working on a call to action for local landlords.
  - City of Henderson is wrapping up ESG contracts for outreach for the 2022 fiscal year.
  - CLV is working on contract negotiations and extensions of ESG outreach.
  - CNLV has executed addendums for the CDBG, ESG and reallocating funds after spend down.
- **Youth Homeless Demonstration Program**
  - The team discussed the Youth Needs Assessment.
  - The team has formed a group called the Continuous Quality Control Improvement group.
  - This group will review quantitative data to better understand youth homelessness in the community.
  - Listening sessions will be held on September 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup>
  - Youth Summit will take place in early November.
  - The team will continue to review data to measure equity within the system.
- **2022 CoC Competition updates**
  - NOFO due on September 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - Applications due on August 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - The NOFO summary will contain the changes made by HUD.
  - Changes to DV bonus projects and scoring factors.
  - Tribes can apply for funding.
  - More flexibility with transitional grants.
  - Rapid rehousing to permanent supportive housing no longer limited to 50% of the budget allowed.
  - Revised and expanded factors added regarding LGBTQ.
