Accomplishments - Action Items Completed:

Review of the Gannt Chart

- o The group discussed the GANNT CHART of the Local Application Process
- During the month of April, the team will develop application instructions.
- Request SPM improvement strategies from DSIWG for the consolidated application.
- Ensure Zoom Grants is ready for the competition.
- The group will recruit PLE to support the development of local competition tools and participate in SRT scoring tools and threshold.
- Develop renewal and new project scoring tools

• 2022 CoC Competition updates

- o The CoC team will meet with the third-party facilitator to discuss the contract process and next steps.
- o The Southern Nevada CoC was awarded all Tier 1 and Tier 2 projects apart from the DV Bonus.
- o The team is working to consolidate grant application platforms into one database.
- o The group will form an ad-hoc group to discuss and prepare for the DV bonus portion of the application.

Local Application Process

- The team is working with the Community Engagement Working Group to develop a recruitment strategy with new and renewal projects.
- o The group will release a public announcement for phase 1 renewal projects.
- The team will meet with the community engagement working group to discuss.

Zoom Grants

- o The team met with representatives from Zoom Grants to discuss buildout.
- Buildout will include a dual submission process.
- o Completion should wrap up mid-May.

DV Bonus Project

- o The team held a preliminary meeting to gage interest.
- o Follow-up meeting to be scheduled this month.

Jurisdictional Updates

- o CLV conducted a second-year funding renewal process in which agencies were evaluated for continued funding.
- CLV is continuing to fund street outreach, rapid rehousing, and homeless prevention services.
- o CNLV is working on the spend down of their CDBG and ESG projects.
- Clark County is working on the reallocation of RRH funding.
- o Funds will be reallocated to the Salvation Army and St. Jude's Ranch.
- COH is working n the spend down of ESG-CV funding received from the state.
- o COH has also posted their action plan for public comment.
