Introduction to CPLC Nevada

- Chicanos Por La Causa (CPLC) was founded by a group of community activists in 1969 to confront oppression facing the Latino community in South Central Phoenix.
- The organization has expanded significantly since that time to encompass a wide range of social and economic programs in Nevada, Arizona, New Mexico, Texas and California.
- CPLC expanded into Nevada offering housing counseling services and economic development opportunities, starting in October 2010 when they opened their first office in Las Vegas.
- CPLC Nevada now offers a broad range of programs including Homeless Services, Housing Opportunities for persons with AIDS (HOPWA), Behavioral Health and Pediatric Mental Health; Housing Counseling & Education; Prestamos Small Business Lending, Parenting Nevada; Workforce Solutions and YouthBuild; and Real Estate Development.

CPLC & DETR's Primary Goals

- Assist 215 Adult Dislocated Workers (ADW) ages 25 - 54 find long-term jobs and fill the workforce gap that Nevada employers are currently facing.
- Meet job seekers at various access points and initiate expedited intake, assessments and service delivery so that clients may enter high-growth career pathways as quickly as possible.
- Connect clients with the necessary education, workforce training and supportive services to overcome barriers for education and employment success.
- Check pulses; not just boxes! Some clients will need supportive services throughout the process, to include follow-up periods after the program to support retention and success of their educational and employment journey.
- Reduce the risk of housing and food insecurity through workforce solutions.

Eligibility

- Must be an ADW * between the ages of 25 – 54 years of age.
- There will be a 60 – day onboarding process consisting of a comprehensive assessment intake.
- Must have legal right to work in the United States. (I-9, social security card)
- Services will be provided at the CPLC office located at 555 N. Maryland Pkwy., LV, NV 89101.
- Supportive services will not be provided prior to client's enrollment.

- *ADW – Adult Dislocater Worker is defined as someone who has:
 - Received a notice of termination or layoff
 - Are employed at a facility that has announced it will close
 - Are dependent on another family member's income but are no longer supported by that family member's income
 - Are the dependent spouse of a member of the U.S. Armed Forces on active duty
 - Combating housing instability
 - Evictions
 - Underemployed
 - Receiving SNAP benefits

Timeline

- Program ramp up period October 06, 2023 – December 31, 2023
- Program begins January 01, 2024 – December 31, 2024

Governor's Reserve DETR GRANT Summary

- CPLC is the Grantee of a \$1.6M Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation (DETR) Grant.
- The grant will provide education, job training and supportive services to 215 ADW ages 25 – 54 years of age.
- The Program will begin January 01, 2024, and end December 31, 2024.
- Bi-lingual and bi-cultural service are available.
- CPLC welcomes collaborating partnerships with other agencies and organizations that can provide supportive services to ensure educational and employment success of its clients.
