Southern Nevada Homeless Continuum of Care (SNHCoC) Performance Measurement Methodology In 2024 for the Local CoC Competition (Replacing the V3)

The SNHCoC project monitoring process for CoC-funded programs is in transition. The most recent monitoring process will be replaced with a process that is currently in development and will not roll out until 2025. For this transitional year, monitoring and scoring from 2023 will carry forward into 2024, except for performance measurement. For performance measurement, the CoC will replace the V3 tool used in prior cycles with data pulled from HUD Annual Performance Reports (APRs) generated from the HMIS system (or, for DV programs, a comparable database), covering the period from January 1 to December 31 2023 (CY 2023).

The table below summarizes the measures, how they will be calculated, and how they will be scored. In developing this approach, the CoC NOFO Consulting Team (Elaine DeColigny Associates) has used the following guidelines:

- To the maximum extent possible, we are using the same performance factors used in the V3.
- Whenever possible, we calculated performance using the same methodology as HUD, and sought for the calculations to be as simple and transparent as possible.
- Benchmarks for scoring (i.e. what level of performance is needed for maximum points) were developed by calculating performance for all currently funded CoC projects, identifying average performance for each factor, and setting the point scales such that the majority of projects are able to receive full or partial points. The benchmarks are not intended to be punitive or unrealistic, particularly in this transitional year, when there has not been the opportunity to engage the community in a more involved process to set community-wide goals.
