The ESG Program is funded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and is authorized by the HUD McKinney-Vento and amended by the HEARTH Act. The purpose of the ESG Program is to rapidly re-house homeless individuals and families, prevent families and individuals from becoming homeless, improve the number and quality of emergency shelters for homeless individuals and families, help operate shelters, and provide funding to engage homeless individuals and families living on the street.

ESG funds administered by Clark County are being made available to eligible nonprofit organizations that provide critical services to homeless individuals and families in Southern Nevada.

During the 2025-2026 grant period (7/1/2025-6/30/2026), Clark County ESG funds will focus on projects related to homelessness prevention.

A pre-application must completed and approved before being permitted to complete the full application for this funding. The deadline for the pre-application is **MONDAY**, **JANUARY 6**, **2025 AT 5:00 P.M PST.** The deadline for submitting completed on-line Emergency Solutions Grant program applications will be **FRIDAY**, **JANUARY 31**, **2024**, **AT 5:00 P.M. PST.** No exceptions will be made and no extensions will be granted. Only on-line applications will be accepted through ZoomGrants.
