At RTC, miguel convenes social service providers to implement mobility strategies in the Coordinated Transportation Plan, including pop-up farmers markets and social service fairs at the Bonneville Transit Center. He also co-leads the Southern Nevada Strong Inventory of Vacant and Underutilized Land to promote investment in neglected neighborhoods. Prior to joining RTC, miguel worked with the Office of Senator Cortez Masto, where he was instrumental in securing the release of approximately \$18 million in mortgage assistance from the U.S. Department of Treasury to Nevada homeowners. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from the University of Nevada Las Vegas (UNLV) and a Master's Degree in City Planning from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT).
