**Agenda Item 1. Call to Order.**

The meeting of the Southern Nevada Homelessness Continuum of Care Board was called to order at 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 25<sup>th</sup> 2026, at the Clark County Government Center.

The Collaborative Applicant (CA) Team provided an overview of the available planning grant funds, noting a current balance of \$136,839.25. During prior meetings, the Board expressed interest in allocating these funds toward Technical Assistance. Accordingly, a proposal was submitted to the National Alliance to End Homelessness (NAEH) for technical assistance focused on strategic planning implementation and goal setting. The Board voted to proceed with NAEH, contingent upon their ability to operate within the proposed scope of work and budget. The CA Team will provide a status update at the March 25 Board meeting.

**Agenda Item 5. Strategic Planning Implementation; for possible action.**

The Board engaged in discussion regarding the implementation of the strategic plan. Board Chair Miguel Davila Uzcategui, Community Advocate, will distribute a draft of the strategic plan to the CoC Core Committee members for review and feedback, with responses requested by March 11. The revised draft will then be presented to the CoC Membership at the March 12 meeting, with feedback due by March 24. The Technical Assistance Providers will incorporate all input and finalize the strategic plan for implementation.
