Continuum of Care (CoC) Board	Last Meeting: 02/25/2026
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Decisions within past month + Rationale

- The Nevada Housing Division presented their Annual Action Plan.
- Collaborative Applicant (CA) shared information with the Board regarding the upcoming spring board nominations.
- The Board discussed a memo that was sent out regarding the FY2026 NOFO

Other significant actions or focus areas:

- The Board voted to approve the 3-phase approach to the Monitoring process.
- For Q1 2026 of the Board’s Strategic Plan draft, a primary action item is compiling a comprehensive asset map of existing housing resources, new and preservation projects, and affordability tracking to identify inventory gaps and support regional alignment and adoption by jurisdictions and housing groups, with an annual review of the housing development pipeline and member focus groups to inform the process.
