The strategic plan is reportedly in a strong position, with drafts completed • Brenda Barnes, Board Member, CCSS provided an update to the board regarding upcoming funding and collaboration opportunities within the homelessness response system. HUD is expected to release the Continuum of Care (CoC) Builds NOFO again, with approximately \$175 million available nationwide for the development of permanent supportive housing projects
